Reward Schools are schools the **highest performing 15%** of Title 1 schools in the state. Reward Schools will be identified every year and will be asked by the state to share any best practices

Focus Schools are the **10%** of Title 1 schools making the biggest contribution to the state's achievement gap. Focus Schools will be identified once every three years and will develop a school improvement plan that directly addresses poor performance either within a subgroup, or in graduation rates.

Priority Schools are the **5% most persistently low performing** Title 1 schools. Priority schools will be identified once every three years will receive support from MDE and newly created Regional Centers of Excellence to develop a school turnaround plan based on the federal turnaround principles.

19 of the initial Priority Schools are currently operating under the School Improvement Grant program. These schools will have the opportunity exit the list in 2013 if they are no longer in the bottom 25% of Title I schools.
