NEW: SCHOOL LIBRARY AID - (MN Statutes 134.356)

FUNDING

Charter schools receive equals the greater of \$16.11 per pupil or \$20,000 for FY24 and later

ALLOWABLE USES

- Salaries and benefits of school library media specialist
- Electronic, computer, and audiovisual equipment
- Information technology infrastructure and digital tools
- Electronic and material resources
- Furniture, equipment, or supplies

SCHOOL LIBRARY AID EFFECTIVE - FY24

NEW: LIBRARIES AND MEDIA CENTERS – (MN Statutes 124D.901)

A school library or school library media center provides equitable and free access to students, teachers, and administrators.

A library or media center must have the following characteristics:

- Ensure every student has equitable access to resources and is able to locate, access, and use organized and catalogued resources
- Has a **collection development plan** that at a minimum includes materials selection and deselection, a challenged materials procedure, and an intellectual and academic freedom statement
- Is **housed in a central location** that provides an environment for expanded learning and supporting a variety of student interests
- Has technology and internet access
- Is served by a licensed school library media specialist or licensed school librarian
