AMERICAN INDIAN AND INDIGENOUS EDUCATION

NEW: RELIGIOUS AND CULTURAL OBSERVANCES 120A.35

A School <u>must make reasonable efforts</u> to accommodate students who wished to be excused from a curricular activity for:

- A religious observance
- American Indian cultural practice, observance or ceremony

School boards <u>must provide annual notice</u> to parents of the school's policy relating to absence from school for religious or cultural practices.

NEW: PROHIBITION ON AMERICAN INDIAN MASCOT TIMELINE CHANGE 121A.041 Subd.2

A school <u>cannot</u> have or adopt a name, symbol or image that depicts or refers to an American Indian Tribe, individual custom or tradition as a mascot.

- This takes effect in September of 2026 (previously 2025).
- Schools with prohibited mascots must report to the Education Chairs of the legislature either confirming they have removed the mascot and selected a new mascot, or a summary of their progress and resources needed to finalize the removal.

NEW: SMUDGING PERMITTED 121A.08

Schools <u>must allow</u> American Indian students and staff members to use tobacco, sage, sweetgrass and cedar to conduct individual or group smudging in school.

The school or building administrator will determine the process for conducting smudging.

The school or building administrator must determine who is the appropriate staff to be present to supervise the smudging process.
