UNEQUAL LONG-TERM FACILITIES MAINTENANCE REVENUE



Long-Term Facilities Maintenance Revenue (LTFMR) provides school funding for specific facilities maintenance needs that are essential for maintaining a healthy school environment.



LTFMR is used in traditional districts for implementing health and safety programs that comply with environmental regulations and best practices, including indoor air quality management and remediation of lead hazards. A chartered public school may use this revenue "for any purpose related to the school."



Traditional districts receive \$380 per pupil

Chartered Public schools only receive \$132 per pupil.

All Minnesota students deserve equally safe school facilities no matter which public school they attend.



POLICY SOLUTION:

Provide chartered public school students with equal Long-Term Facilities Maintenance Revenue of \$380 per pupil.
