



UNEQUAL EXTENDED TIME REVENUE

Traditional school districts receive extended time revenue funding for important programming such as extended day programs, extended week programs, summer school, and vacation break programming.

Currently, extended time revenue is not offered equally to all MN Public School Students.



UP TO **\$1023 PER PUPIL**

Traditional districts can receive funding of up to .2 of additional per pupil general revenue or \$1,023 per pupil in FY22.



UP TO **\$13.81 PER PUPIL**

Current law provides charter schools with only 25% of the state average of extended time revenue generated by traditional districts or \$13.81 per pupil in FY22.



EQUAL FUNDING

All charter school students deserve to have equal access to full extended time revenue for life changing educational opportunities and support.
